LEPRECHAUN ADVENTURES

EXPLORE OUTSIDE

SEARCH FOR LEPRECHAUNS. Grab a pair of binoculars (or decorate a paper towel roll to make a leprechaun looker) and head outside to look for leprechauns!

DIY LEPRECHAUN OBSTACLE COURSE: Design a Leprechaun obstacle course. What types of things would a leprechaun have to do to find a pot of gold?

LEARN

WORD FUN: Brainstorm green words. What things are green? What words start with the letter G? Make a list or a collage of images. (*Preschoolers*)
