YARN WRAPPED BIRD

MATERIALS

- Cardboard Bird Shape
- Yarn
- Googly Eye
- Pattern Paper (2 Sheets)
- 2 Clothes Pins
- Scissors
- Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

Cut small slits all around your cardboard bird shape. (If you purchased a kit, this is already done for you!)

Wrap the yard around the bird, securing it into a different slit every time you wrap. Continue until the bird is covered.

Cut a beak and a wing out of your patterned paper.

Glue beak, googly eye, and wing to your bird. Attach clothespins as legs. Chirp! You have a bird!
